Committee of the Whole meeting notes:

- Water is important
- Section 4.1.6 – The trails master plan recommendation should specify that it be developed in collaboration with the City of Dawson
- Could the Land Stewardship Trust be used for recreation projects?
 - 4.3.2 – Stewardship recommendation “trappers, miners...” should include recreation users too.
- For the Klondike Highway Corridor, would City of Dawson be on the list of “applicable organizations”?
- Will there be opportunities to give specific input on the Klondike Valley?
- Are there recommendations related to ORV and the new ORV Regulations? Are there special areas identified in the plan related to ORV?

City Staff meeting notes

- Curious about what area development plans already exist
- How were boundaries determined?
- Who is responsible for sub-regional planning?
- How could the plan affect other jurisdictions and plans that aren’t yet developed, particularly interested in the subregional plan for the Yukon River?
- Keen to understand how this plan will layer with other plans and the hierarchy .
- Recommendation for the appendix table for actions / policy / research (implementation): clearly identify the appropriate actor as it will help pinpoint information easily, and tie responsibility clearly
- How will the plan deal with overlapping claim blocks that spread across more than one LMU?
- Will the plan adopt new mitigations over time?
- The level of detail in the plan seems good.
- Would like a simpler version of the land designation map – only 3 categories
 - SMAs
 - ISAs
 - Future Planning
- The key planning issues identified in the Dawson City area are good. They reflect the current issues.
