

Overview of the Government of Yukon's Response to the Recommended Dawson Regional Land Use Plan

In addition to the high-level breakdown of the issues mentioned in the preceding letter, the Government of Yukon has also collated the observations and comments of our planning practitioners, scientific and technical staff who reviewed the Recommended Plan. We are pleased to provide these for your consideration, specifically:

- **Memo**
 - Additional detail or explanation of proposed modifications that we felt could not be adequately addressed in one of the other submission documents.
- **Map**
 - Proposed boundary and designation changes for Landscape Management Units.
- **Rationales for major proposed changes that were previously provided to Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in.**
 - Expanded rationales for high priority concerns with Recommended Plan and suggested changes that were previously provided to Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in.
- **Tracked changes version of the Recommended Plan**
 - Edits and commentary on entire Recommended Plan, including specific changes recommended in other documents in this submission.
 - Includes two files: tracked change versions of the Recommended Plan text and the Plan map package.
- **Proposed changes for effective document design and writing style**
 - Proposed modifications to the Recommended Plan's structure and writing style to improve effectiveness of the planning document, reduce risk of misinterpretation, and increase the feasibility of the Plan's implementation.
- **Recommendations Table**
 - All management directions, recommendations to the Parties and special management directions from the Recommended Plan with suggested modifications including recommendations on whether directions should remain in the main text of the Plan or move to an Appendix.
- **Summary Table**
 - High-level synopsis of all changes proposed and the location of each change
- **Scenarios Report**
 - Reflects the Government of Yukon's learnings from a scenarios exercise hosted by Government of Yukon and Tr'ondëk Hwëch'in designed to identify gaps in the Recommended Plan related to the implementation of projects in the Dawson planning area. We are sharing a report to acknowledge the important contributions of the scenario exercise participants, and to meet our obligations to them.
